Our project at Bengal Street, Khandallah, has received a 2008 NZIA Wellington Award for Architecture. The jury citation read:

“Through clear conceptual moves this alteration cleverly transformed the living spaces of a traditional house. The surprise alignment of the addition with the boundary, accesses sunshine, allows generous outdoor living space and conceals well-planned amenity areas. The overall design was successful in transforming the lifestyle of the occupants beyond their expectations”

The project was also published in the 2008 Houses New Zealand Kitchens and Bathrooms annual. This is the second award for the practice – our dental surgery fitout for Keith Chapman and Morris Wong Partnership received both Architecture and Colour awards in 2006.
